

**Supplementary Regulations**  
**SOCIAL SATURDAY**  
**RACE SUNDAY**  
**Kyneton 25-26 June 2011**

**1. Title and Authority**

The event will be a non-competitive “Test n Tune” and “Social Club” events on Saturday, and a Mini Buggy Off-Road Short Course event on Sunday (hereafter called the event). Conducted on a dirt surface, the event shall be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of CAMS., The TORC Sporting Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any other further regulations that may be issued. The event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)

This event will be subject to CAMS Permit No: 311/2606/06

**5. The Track**

The track is a dirt surface and consists of number of turns, left and right. The Start and Finish lines are in the same spot. The length of the course is approximately 1.0 Kilometre.

**6. Competition Vehicles**

The Classes will consist of Odyssey: FL250, Odyssey Mini Sprint, and Odyssey Super Modified, Pro Lite and Pro Max Class

**7. Scrutiny**

Scrutiny of all competition and Social Club vehicles will take place at the venue, on Saturday 25/06/11, and Sunday 26/06/11 between the hours of 7.30am and 9.30am. No vehicle will be allowed to take part in the competition unless it has been scrutineered.

**8. Drivers Briefing.**

A compulsory drivers briefing will be held at 9.30am Saturday and Sunday.

**9. Entries and Fees**

Entries will open on the approval of these supplementary regulations.

For club competitors paying by direct deposit, race entries must be received by 5.00PM **24/06/11** Via Mail / E-Mail. Race entry fee will be \$75.00 and an additional \$10.00 Fee for the Co-Driver. A maximum of 20 entries of each class will be accepted. The promoter reserves the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR83. Entries close Sunday **26/06/11** at 9.30am.

For social club participants, entries close Saturday 25/06/11 at 9.30am. Entry fee is \$25.00

## **10. Competitor Eligibility**

All Competitors and Drivers in the Mini Buggy Racing event & Test and Tune must be a financial member of the TORC Offroad Racing Club and have a current CAMS **Level 2S (or superior) Licence**. This documentation must be presented at pre event scrutiny along with a CAMS vehicle logbook (if issued).

Participants in the Social Club event will be able to purchase a day membership of TORC and a CAMS L2SE Licence (1 day licence) at the event.

## **11. Pit Crews**

All members of the crew must be nominated.

## **12. Abandonment**

The promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel this event in accordance with N.C.R. 59. Upon approval from CAMS the organiser may retain up to 25% of the entry fee.

## **13. Anti Doping Policy**

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

## **14. Safety**

All drivers and their pit crew are reminded that the wearing of correct safety apparel is required (Schedule D of the CAMS Manual). The wearing clothing of non-inflammable material from neck to wrist to ankle, a helmet complying with AS 1698 and gloves must be worn. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual. All vehicles must be adequately muffled. Refer to the T.O.R.C. Handbook and the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Any competing vehicle involved in an accident, must be presented to the scrutiny bay for inspection by the chief scrutineer, prior to continuing competition.

## **15. Vehicle Eligibility**

All competing vehicles in the Mini Buggy Racing event must comply with the technical requirements of the current TORC Inc. handbook. Vehicles competing in the Social Club event will be permitted at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer and Clerk Of Course.

## **16. Starting**

A maximum of Six (6) vehicles during competition will be allowed on the track at any time.

## **17. Timing**

No timing will be conducted at this event on Saturday however timing will be conducted on Sunday. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

## **18. Awards and Presentation**

Awards will be presented to competitors ranked 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> in each category, with points given towards the end of year trophies for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> overall.

## **19. Insurance**

Insurance has been affected by the promoter in accordance with Appendix I of the CAMS Manual.

## **20. Practice Session**

A practice session may be conducted on Saturday 25/06/11 for race competitors between 3.00pm and 4.00pm and on Sunday from 9.30am to 9.45am at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. Vehicles must be scrutinised before participating in the practice session.

## **21. Social Club Event**

The running of the Social Club event will be in strict accordance with the controls specified within the Targeted Risk Assessment of 9 February 2009 as approved by CAMS.
